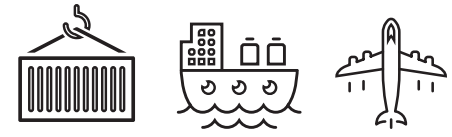


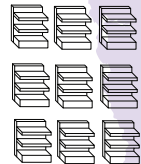
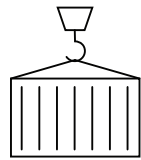
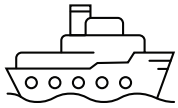
# IMPORtant Planning.



A retail fixture supplier that had traditionally manufactured their components domestically, started producing fixtures overseas. For their first large scale project involving **300 stores** with a new retail customer, they needed a logistics partner they could trust and would work alongside their Project Managers to develop, manage and execute a strategic import plan.

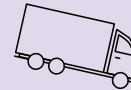
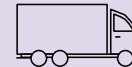
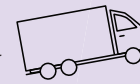

To accomplish this our partner office in Xiamen worked directly with the overseas manufacturing facility to optimize container loading and shipping schedules that would position the fixtures into the US just before the project deadline, eliminating the added expense of extended warehouse storage. We provided **weekly reporting** and **visibility** while containers were on the water, keeping our client informed at every step.

Containers were **received and inventoried** for domestic distribution at our West Coast facility. We then staged the shipments in waves, based on region, to meet the in-store deadlines and successfully complete the project!
